Funding is subject to availability and is on a cost-share, reimbursement basis. Grants will not cover more than 50% of the total cost of the project. Maximum grant awards for individual projects will not exceed \$10,000.

Projects that will impact a large cross-section of producers within a region are encouraged.

CBE reserves the right to follow-up with an onsite visit of the project and to use photos and/or descriptions of the project for future programming and promotion.

Photos of project are helpful, particularly before and after photos that show the impact of the work completed.

Grant funds will not be released until all receipts and evidence of completion are received by CBE.

Application Checklist:

- Projects must be complete or able to be completed by June 1, 2024
- Completed application must be received by 5 pm on the last day of the grant round to be eligible
- Detailed description of operation and project-separate pages can be attached
- A detailed budget of costs from start to finish MUST be included with the application (use form attached or a separate form may be attached). Please include receipts for the total cost of the project.
- Define the impact the project will have:
 - On the individual operation
 - o On the beef industry in Pennsylvania (if applicable)
 - On the regional beef community (if applicable)
- Two references must be submitted with the application who can give insight and support as to why the project should be funded (Example: extension educator, loan officer, conservation district/NRCS employee, etc.)
- Maps and/or drawings of project should be included with application if applicable (ex. Fencing, water lines, etc.)
- Before and after photos of the project should be submitted to show project completion and improvement to operation
